- (a) Commercial General Liability Insurance and Excess Liability providing combined single limits of \$2,000,000 per occurrence for bodily injury (including death) and/ or property damage liability (which insurance should cover, at a minimum, liability arising from products and completed operations, personal injury/advertising injury, host liquor liability, TRIA or any future renewal program thereof to include noncertified terrorism, and contractual liability);
- (b) Automobile Liability Insurance with combined single limits of \$2,000,000 per accident for bodily injury (including death) and property damage liability;
- (c) Statutory Worker's Compensation and Occupational Disease Disability Insurance; and
- (d) Employer's Liability Insurance providing bodily injury (including death) by accident, bodily injury by disease per policy, and bodily injury by disease per employee, with liability limits of no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
